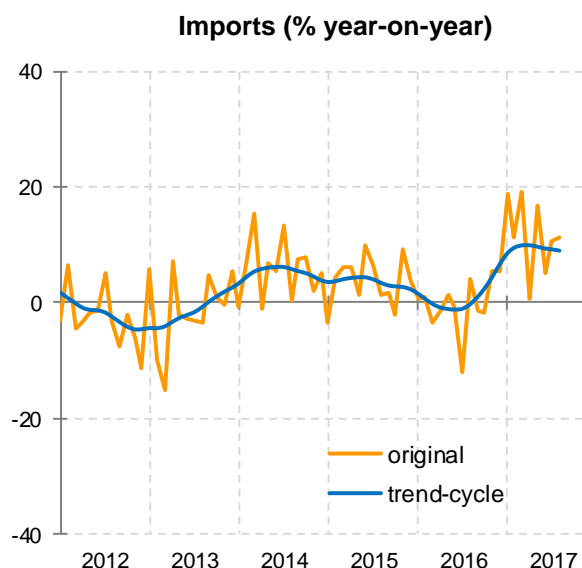
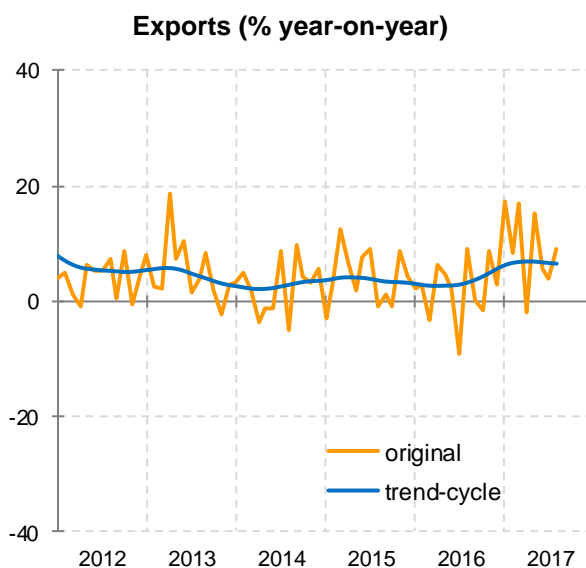

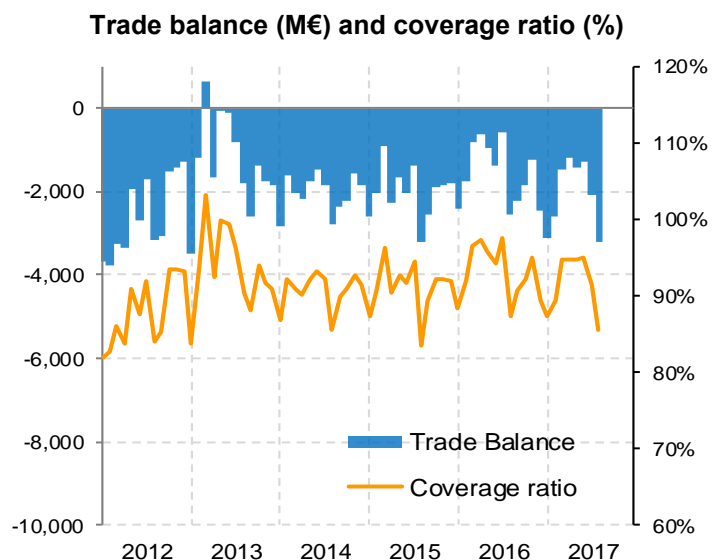


## AUGUST 2017

In August 2017, **Spain's exports increased by 9.0%** year-on-year in nominal terms to 19,237.7 million euros, whereas **imports expanded by 11.2%** to 22,464.3 million euros. With seasonally adjusted data, exports grew also by 9.0% year-on-year, while imports increased by 11.3%. In **real terms**, exports advanced by 9.6% year-on-year, as export prices fell by 0.5%, and imports expanded by 7.0%, as import prices augmented by 3.9%. In nominal terms on a **month-on-month** basis, exports fell by 13.3% and imports declined by 7.5%. With seasonally adjusted data, on the contrary, exports expanded by 4.5% month-on-month and imports rose by 1.4%.

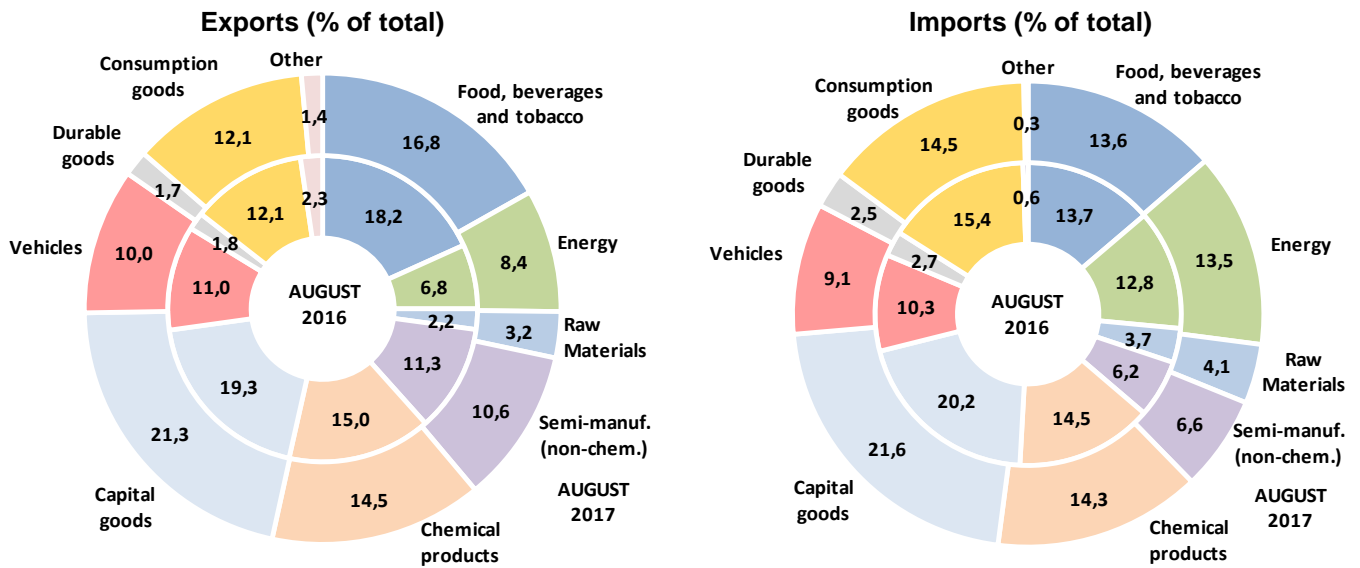


Spain's **trade balance** registered a deficit of 3,226.7 million euros, up from a deficit of 2,560.2 million euros in August 2016 (provisional data). The export/import **coverage ratio** reached 85.6%, 1.7 percentage points lower than in the same month of 2016 (87.3% in August 2016 with provisional data). The **non-energy trade balance** reached a deficit of 1,808.6 million euros, up from a deficit of 1,169.6 million in the same month of 2016. The **energy trade deficit** increased by 2.0% year-on-year to 1,418.1 million euros (compared to a deficit of 1,390.5 million euros in August 2016).



### Sectoral data

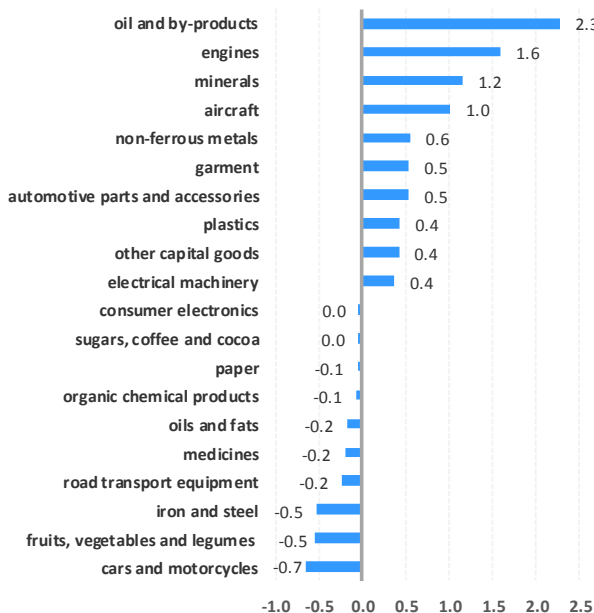
Spain's **main exporting sectors** in August 2017 were *capital goods* (21.3% of total exports and growing by 20.5% year-on-year), *food, beverages and tobacco* (16.8% of total, advancing by 0.5%), *chemical products* (14.5% of total, rising by 4.9%) and *consumption goods* (12.1% of total, surging by 9.4%).



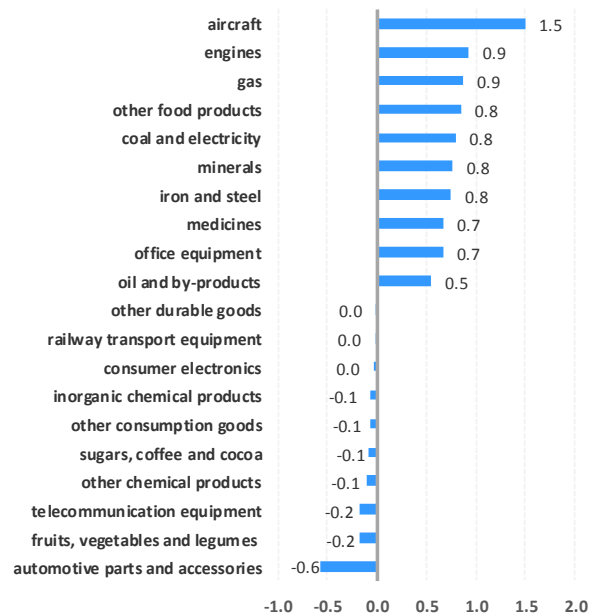
The **most significant sectors of Spain's imports** were *capital goods* (representing 21.6% of total imports and rising by 18.8% year-on-year), *consumption goods* (14.5% of total, advancing by 4.5%), *chemical products* (14.3% of total, increasing by 9.3%) and *food, beverages and tobacco* (13.6% of total, growing by 10.1%).

Among **subsectors, the largest contributions** to the annual change in Spain's exports in August 2017 (up by 9.0%) came from *oil and by-products* (2.3 points), *engines* (1.6 points) and *minerals* (1.2 points). The major negative contributions corresponded to *cars and motorcycles* (-0.7 points), *fruits, vegetables and legumes* (-0.5 points) and *iron and steel* (-0.5 points).

Exports (top/bottom contrib. to annual change, p.p.)



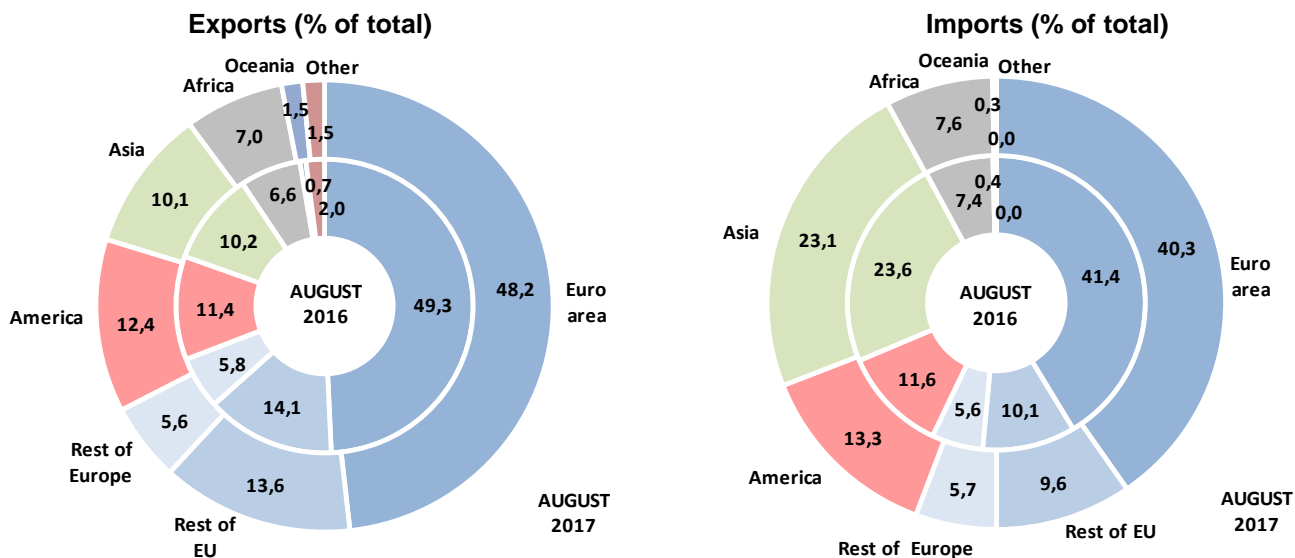
Imports (top/bottom contrib. to annual change, p.p.)



The **subsectors with the most positive contribution** to the annual change in Spain's imports in August 2017 (up by 11.2%) were *aircraft* (1.5 points), *engines* (0.9 points) and *gas* (0.9 points). The major negative contributions corresponded to *automotive parts and accessories* (-0.6 points), *fruits, vegetables and legumes* (-0.2 points) and *telecommunication equipment* (-0.2 points).

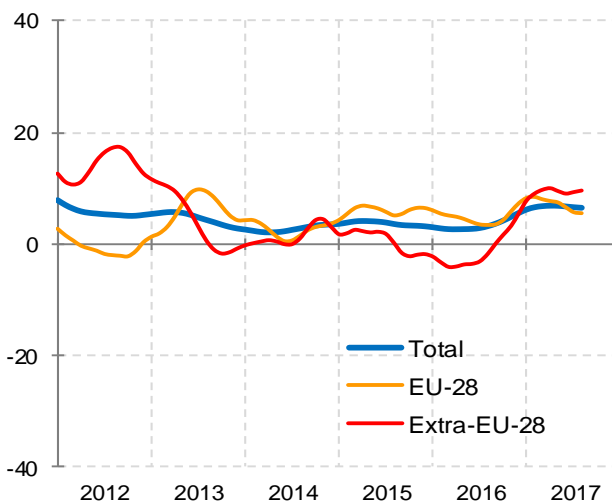
## Geographic data

Exports to the **European Union** accounted for 61.8% of total exports in August 2017 (down from 63.3% in August 2016) and advanced by 6.5% year-on-year. Exports to the **euro area** ran at 48.2% (down from 49.3% in August 2016) and grew by 6.7%. Exports to **non-EU countries** represented 38.2% of total exports (up from 36.7% in August 2016) as they went up by 13.4% year-on-year.

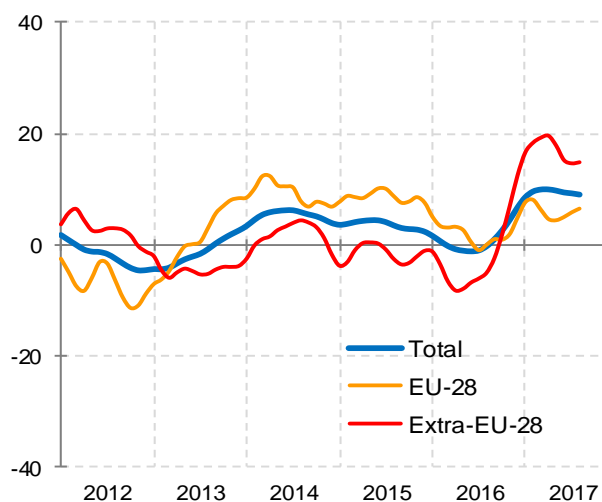


Imports from the **European Union** accounted for 50.0% of total imports in August 2017 (down from 51.5% in August 2016) and augmented by 8.0% year-on-year. Imports from the **euro area** represented 40.3% (down from 41.4% in August 2016) and grew by 8.4%. Imports from **non-EU countries** amounted to 50.0% of total imports in August 2017 (up from 48.5% in August 2016) as they advanced by 14.6% year-on-year.

Exports EU and extra-EU (% y-o-y trend-cycle)



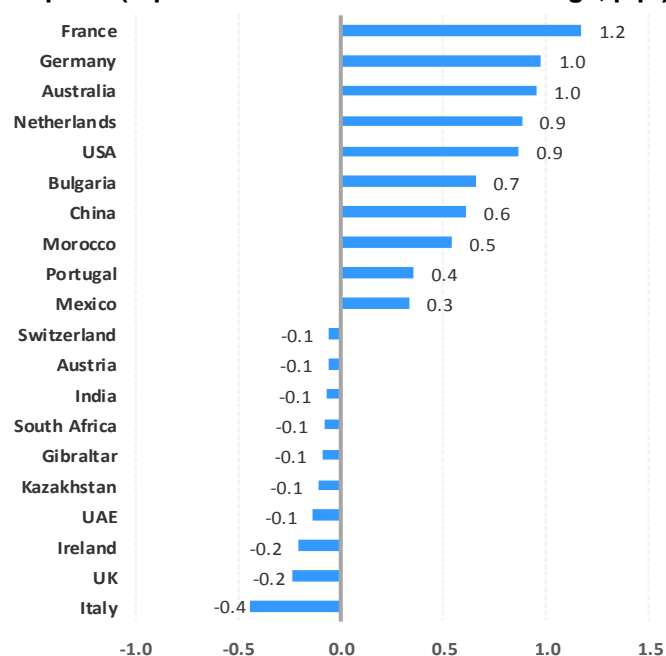
Imports EU and extra-EU (% y-o-y trend-cycle)



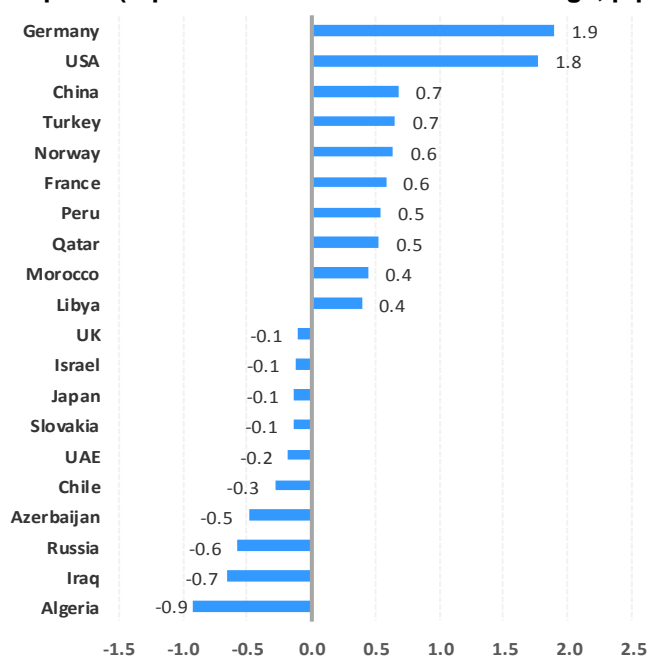
**Trade balance with the European Union** showed in August 2017 a surplus of 666.6 million euros (down from a surplus of 772.4 million in August 2016) and a surplus of 214.1 million euros with the euro area (334.1 million surplus in August 2016). **Trade deficit with the rest of the world** increased to 3,893.3 million euros (from a deficit of 3,332.6 million euros in August 2016).

The **destinations with the largest contributions** to the annual change in Spain's **exports** in August 2017 (up by 9.0%) were France (1.2 percentage points), Germany (1.0 points), Australia (1.0 points) and the Netherlands (0.9 points). Those destinations with the largest negative contributions were Italy (-0.4 points), the United Kingdom (-0.2 points), Ireland (-0.2 points) and the United Arab Emirates (-0.1 points).

Regarding **imports**, the **countries with the largest contributions** to the annual change in Spain's **imports** in August 2017 (up by 11.2%) were Germany (1.9 percentage points), the United States (1.8 points), China (0.7 points) and Turkey (0.7 points). The destinations with the largest negative contributions were Algeria (-0.9 points), Iraq (-0.7 points), Russia (-0.6 points) and Azerbaijan (-0.5 points).

## **International data**

**In comparison to other geographical areas**, Spain's exports of goods expanded by 9.0% year-on-year in August, a higher increase than those of the euro area (7.1%) and the European Union (7.2%). Within the European Union, exports also increased in Germany (7.2%), France (3.3%), Italy (8.4%) and in the United Kingdom (10.5%). Outside the European Union, the United States exports increased by 5.5% year-on-year, China's by 4.5% and Japan's by 18.1%.

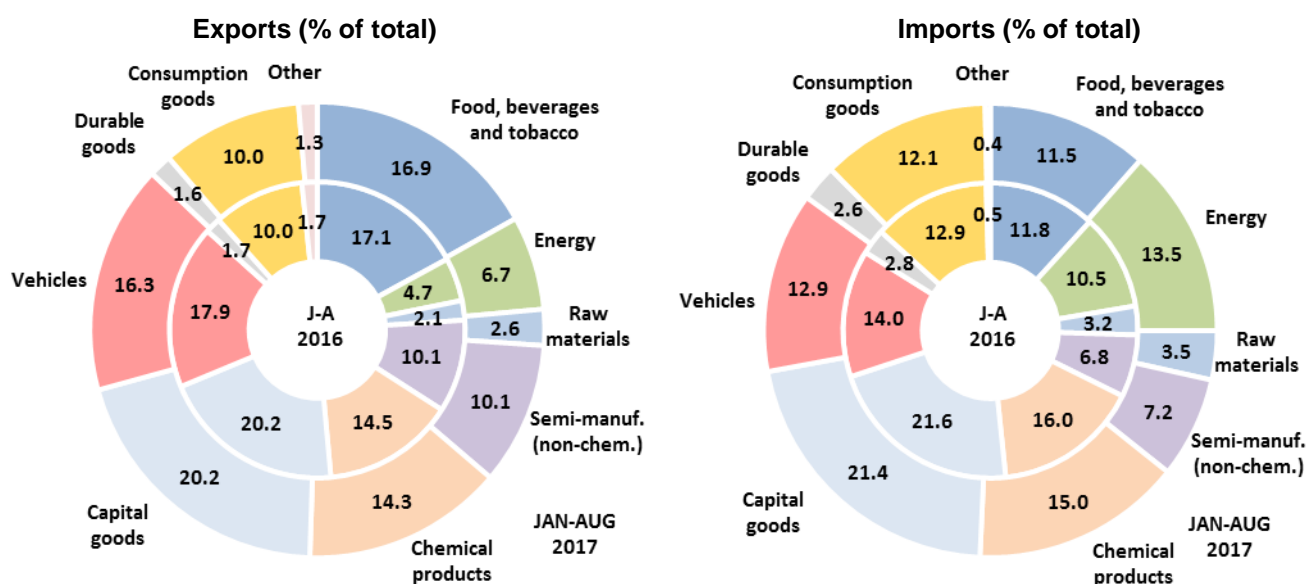
## JANUARY – AUGUST 2017

**Spain's exports expanded by 9.1%** in the period of January-August 2017 compared to the same period of 2016 to 182,302.1 million euros, whereas imports advanced by 11.6% year-on-year to 198,716 million euros. In real terms, exports increased by 9.0% year-on-year, as export prices advanced by 0.2%, and imports rose by 6.0% year-on-year, as import prices grew by 5.3%.

**Spain's trade deficit** increased to 16,413.8 million euros compared to the same period of 2016 (deficit of 10,996.3 million euros). The export/import **coverage ratio** reached 91.7%, 2.1 percentage points lower than in the same period of 2016 (93.8%, provisional data). The **non-energy trade balance** reached a deficit of 1,721 million euros, compared to a deficit of 156 million euros in January-August 2016, whereas the **energy trade deficit** increased by 35.5% year-on-year to 14,692.8 million euros.

### Sectoral data

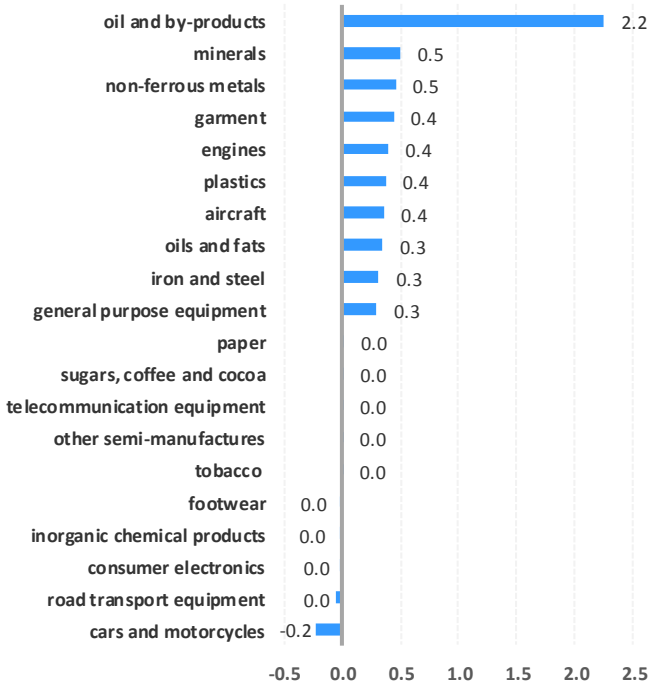
Spain's **main exporting sectors** in the period of January-August were *capital goods* (representing 20.2% of total exports, surging by 9.2% year-on-year), *food, beverages and tobacco* (16.9% of total, growing by 7.9%), *vehicles* (16.3% of total, falling by 0.7%) and *chemical products* (14.3% of total, expanding by 7.8%).



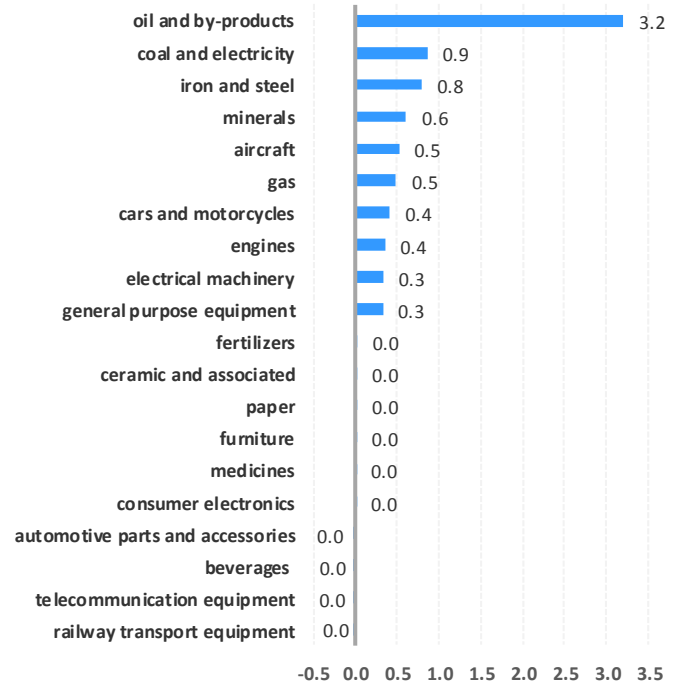
The **largest shares by sector of Spain's imports** were those of *capital goods* (representing 21.4% of total and surging by 10.4% year-on-year), *chemical products* (15.0% of total imports, growing by 4.7%), *energy* (13.5% of total imports, advancing by 43.1%) and *vehicles* (12.9% of total imports, increasing by 2.9%).

Among **subsectors**, the largest contributions to the annual change in Spain's **exports** (up by 9.1%) were *oil and by-products* (2.2 percentage points), *minerals* (0.5 points) and *non-ferrous metals* (0.5 points). On the other hand, the major negative contribution by subsector corresponded to *cars and motorcycles* (-0.2 points).

**Exports (top/bottom contrib. to annual change, p.p.)**



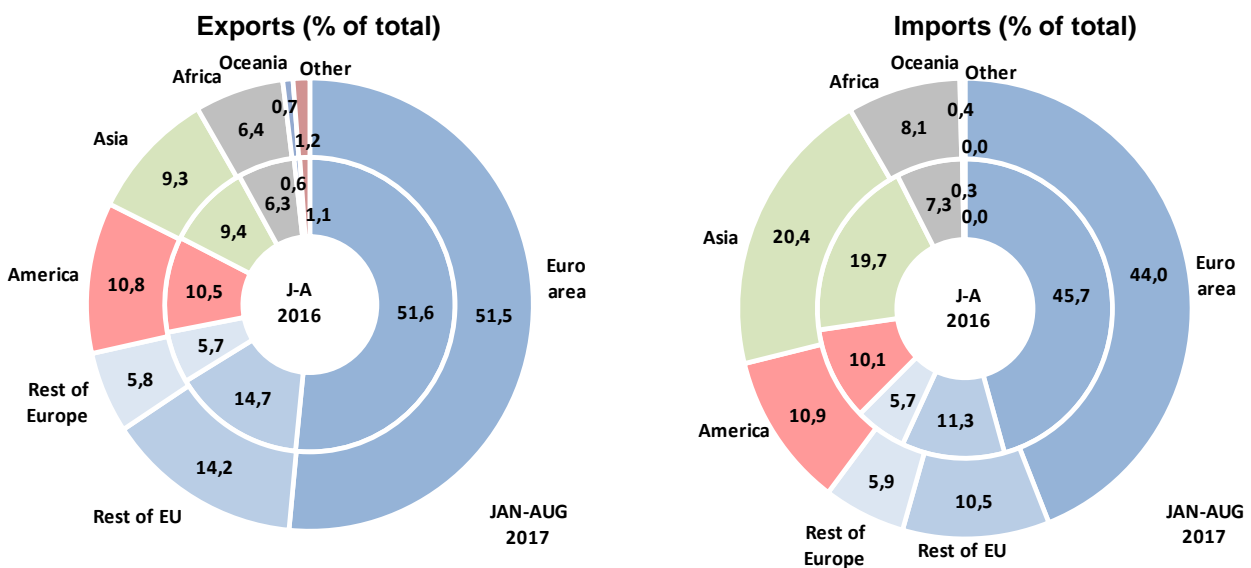
**Imports (top/bottom contrib. to annual change, p.p.)**



The **subsectors with the most positive contributions** to the annual change in Spain's **imports** in January-August 2017 (up by 11.6%) were *oil and by-products* (3.2 points), *coal and electricity* (0.9 points) and *iron and steel* (0.8 points).

**Geographic data**

Exports to the **European Union** accounted for 65.7% of total exports in the period (down from 66.3% in the same period of 2016) and advanced by 8.2% year-on-year, while exports to the **euro area** ran at 51.5% of total (51.6% in the same period of 2016) and expanded by 8.9%. Exports to the **rest of the world** amounted to 34.3% of total exports (33.7% in the same period of 2016) and rowing by 11.0% year-on-year.



Imports from the **European Union** accounted for 54.4% of total imports in January-August 2017 (down from 56.9% in the same period of 2016) and went up 6.7% year-on-year. Imports from the **euro area** ran at 44.0% (45.7% in the same period of 2016) and augmented by 7.5%. Imports from the **rest of the world**

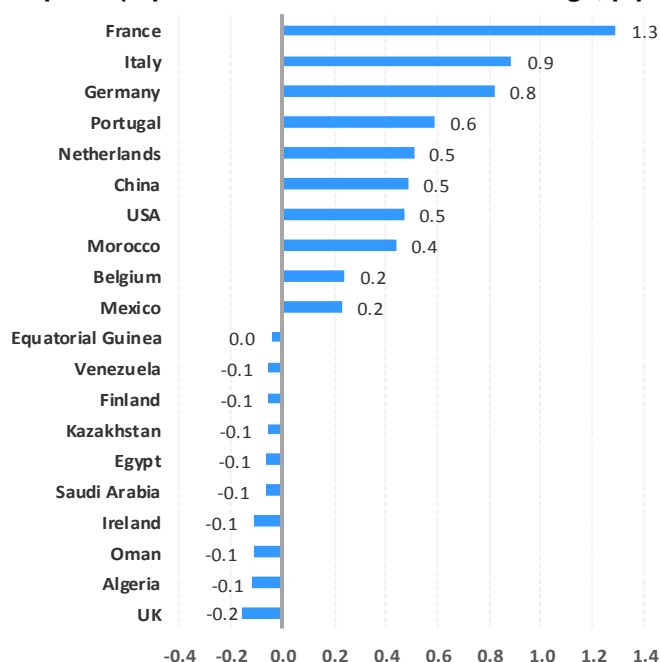


amounted to 45.6% of total imports (43.1% in the same period of 2016) and advanced by 18.1% year-on-year.

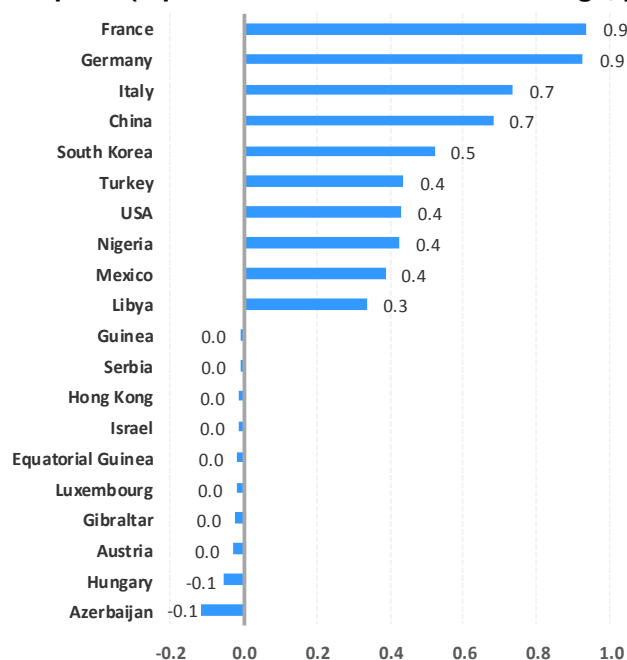
**Spain's trade surplus with the European Union and with the euro area** increased to 11,639.8 million euros and to 6,486.3 million euros respectively, up from surpluses of 9,368.2 million and 4,857.3 million euros in the same period of the previous year. The **trade deficit with the rest of the world** grew by 37.8% year-on-year to 28,053.6 million euros.

In terms of **contribution to the annual change of exports** (up by 9.1%), the main contributions were those of France (1.3 percentage points), Italy (0.9 points), Germany (0.8 points) and Portugal (0.6 points). Those destinations with the largest negative contributions were the United Kingdom (-0.2 points), Algeria (-0.1 points), Oman (-0.1 points), and Ireland (-0.1 points).

**Imports (top/bottom contrib. to annual change, p.p.)**



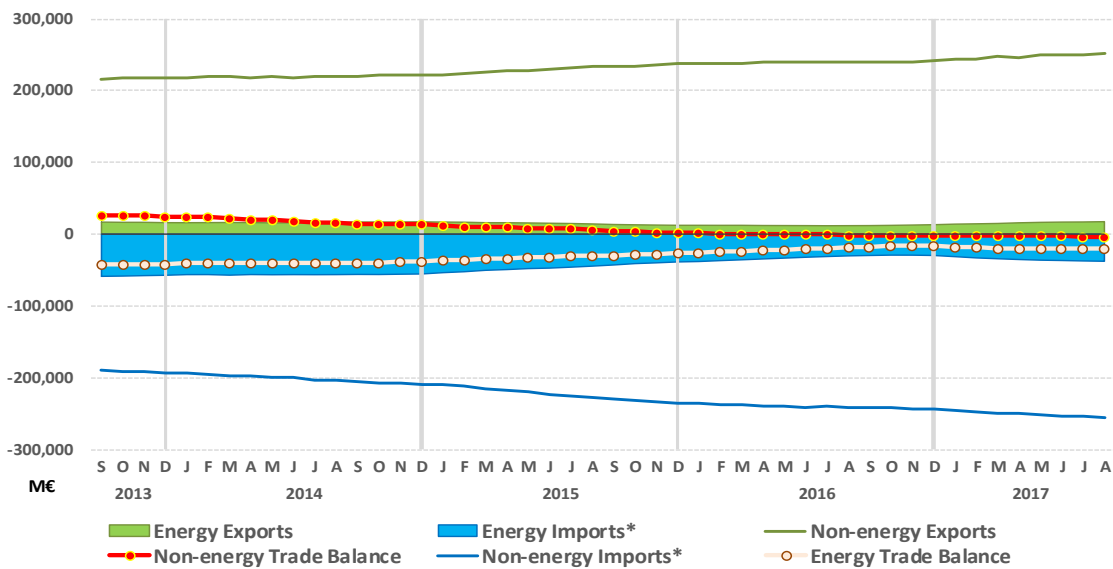
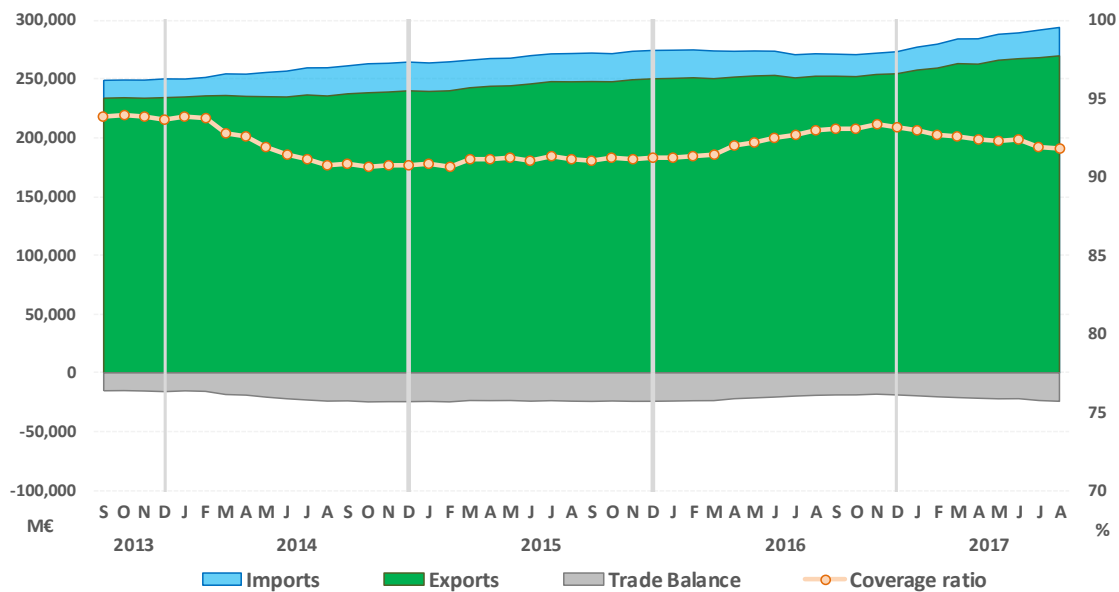
Regarding **imports**, the **countries with the largest contribution** to the annual change in Spain's imports in the period (up by 11.6%) were France (0.9 percentage points), Germany (0.9 points), Italy (0.7 points), and China (0.7 points). The destinations with the largest negative contributions were Azerbaijan (-0.1 points) and Hungary (-0.1 points).

In the period January-August, the number of **Spanish exporters** remained relatively stable at 119,477 exporters, out of which 33,936 had already exported at least 50,000 euros worth of goods in the period, 1.1% more than in the same period of 2016. With regard to regular exporters (those that have already exported in the current year as well as in each of the three preceding years), they amounted to 48,662 in the period, 40.7% of total exporters and 1.8% more than in the same period of 2016. Their exports reached 173,633.5 million, 95.2% of total exports and 9.8% more than in the same period of the previous year.

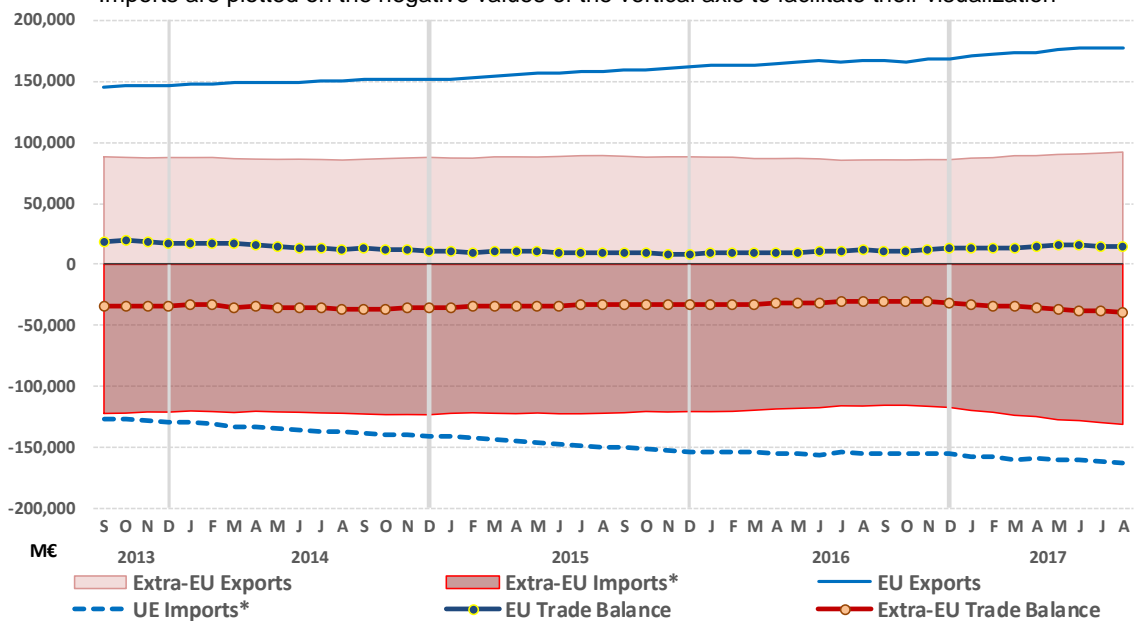
## International data

**In comparison to other geographical areas**, Spain's exports of goods expanded by 9.1% year-on-year in the period of January-August 2017, a higher rate than those attained by the euro area (7.6%) and the European Union (7.9%). Within the European Union, exports also grew in Germany (6.5%), France (3.6%), Italy (7.6%) and in the United Kingdom (18.3%). Outside the European Union, the United States exports increased by 6.4% year-on-year, China's by 5.3% and Japan's by 11.0%
